- Pharmacology







EUROPEAN UNIVERSITY CYPRUS

A GLOBAL HUB FOR MEDICAL EDUCATION

With campuses in Nicosia (Cyprus) and Frankfurt (Germany), EUC provides an internationally accredited curriculum emphasising clinical training, research, and global career opportunities. Students benefit from cutting-edge facilities, experienced faculty, and extensive hospital affiliations, ensuring a well-rounded education that prepares them for professional practice worldwide.

Student Benefits:

Progression Requirements:

- Medicine, Dentistry and Veterinary Medicine applicants need ABB in Major Modules, including Biology and one more Science
- Proof of English proficiency is a requirement. Applicants holding British nationality are exempt from English language requirements
- Applicants must provide an academic reference/letter of recommendation
- Applicants must submit a personal statement written in English

Special Considerations:

- No UCAT or BMAT is required; applicants can apply directly
- Medicine applicants will be invited for an interview
- EUC qualifications are recognised in Europe, the US and internationally

Graduates earn an internationally recognised MD, BDS or DVM degree preparing them for global medical, dental and veterinary careers.

- Minimum pass in all Minor Modules
- IELTS for UKVI: 7.0 overall
- UCAT: Minimum score of 2281
- Score in the third decile overall and achieve Band 3 or above in the SJT section

Special Considerations:

- Registered with the World Directory of Medical Schools
- Open to Home, EU and International applicants

Graduates earn the internationally recognised Bachelor of Medicine, Bachelor of Surgery (MBBS) qualification.

- UCAT and BMAT are not required, but a UCAT score is recommended


Special Considerations:

- Direct applications accepted from UFP students (no UCAS needed)
- Guaranteed interview for eligible direct entry applicants
- All accepted students are automatically screened for eligibility for academic and other types of scholarship; if granted, scholarships are applied across the 4-Year MD programme

- No UCAT or BMAT required
- Direct applications accepted from UFP students (no UCAS needed)
- Online interview: Applicants predicted to meet entry requirements may be invited to an online interview, focusing on personal qualities rather than academic questions
- €60 application fee and an administrative fee required upon offer acceptance

Admission interviews assess motivation, language skills, aspirations and commitment to medicine.

- Oral and written Entrance Examinations in Biology and either Chemistry or Physics

Special Considerations:

- No UCAT or BMAT required (a UCAT score is recommended)
- Direct applications accepted from UFP students (no UCAS needed)
- Applicants who meet the academic requirements may be invited for an interview to assess their motivation, language proficiency and commitment to medicine
- Entrance Examinations incur a \$500 USD fee per test (including application fees)

As one of Central Europe's largest higher education institutions, they offer over 100 degree programmes fully taught in English.


- Grades AAA in Major Modules, including Medical Sciences, Chemistry, and one other Major Module Science
- Minimum pass mark in all Minor Modules
- Academic IELTS for UKVI: 7.0 overall, with no component below 7.0

Special Considerations:

- International UFP students at David Game College are guaranteed an interview if predicted AAA (in Medical Sciences, Chemistry, and one other Major Module Science) and IELTS 7.0 in all components
- The university provides exceptional support for student success.

MEDICINE PATHWAY STRUCTURE

The UFP Medicine Pathway is delivered over three terms, combining interactive classroom learning, tutorials and laboratory sessions. Students complete coursework and practical laboratory work, with progress tests throughout the course. Each term ends with an examination for each module.

This structured approach ensures that essential knowledge and skills are developed progressively, balancing theory, practical application and assessments. Below is a detailed breakdown of the modules and activities for each term.

TERM ONE - MINOR MODULES

These modules are compulsory:

- Core Mathematics (Pure & Statistics)
- Information Technology
- Communication Skills or IELTS
- Introductory Biology
- Introductory Chemistry
- Introduction to Studying Medicine
- Weekly sessions in preparation for university applications

TERM TWO & THREE - MAJOR MODULES

The following are all compulsory modules for this Pathway:

- **F** Biology
- Chemistry
- Medical Science (including Human Anatomy & Physiology; Pathology; Pharmacology; Medical Imagery Techniques; and Introduction to Clinical Practice)

The following are elective modules for this pathway. Students must select ONE:

- Psychology
- Quantitative Methods
- Further Mathematics
- Physics

OTHER ROUTES TO MEDICINE

The UFP **Medicine Pathway** will prepare you to apply to Medical School, but if you change your mind during the year, our qualification is also accepted by many UK universities offering related degree subjects. You can also apply to undergraduate degrees in the following degrees.

- F Biomedical Engineering
- Molecular Genetics
- Neuroscience
- Nutrition

We think it's good to know that you always have other options! It is also possible to use these degrees to take an alternative route to Medicine studies as a postgraduate.










ENTRY REQUIREMENTS


